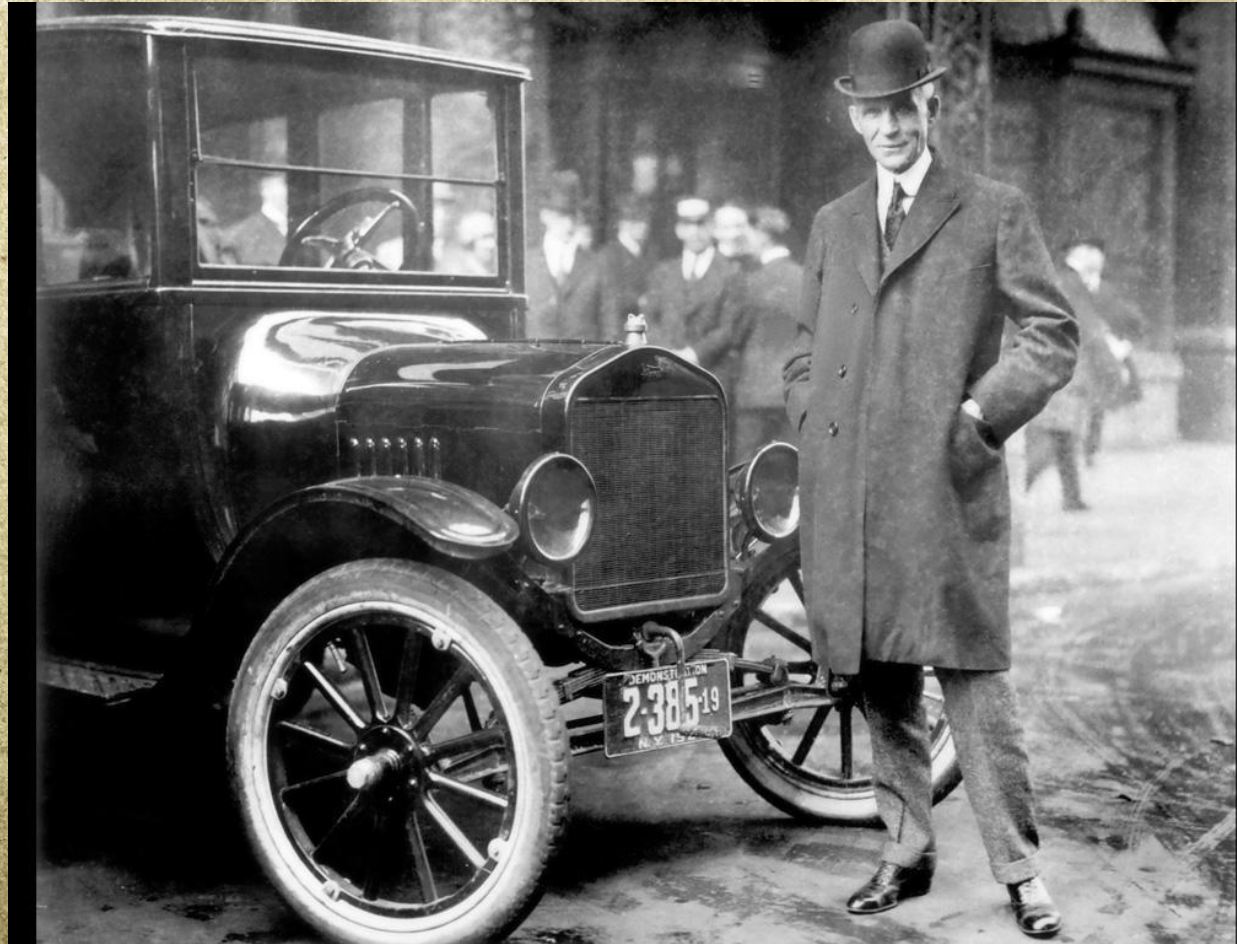

Ford Model T was produced on August 12 1908, and left the factory on September 27 1908.



4: Who invented it

The people who invented the Ford Model T are more than 1 person. Henry Ford the founder of Ford Motor Company in collaboration with Childe Harold Wills, Joseph A. Galamb, and Makin Eugene Farkas who were associates and engineers at the company and contributed to the design of the Model T.



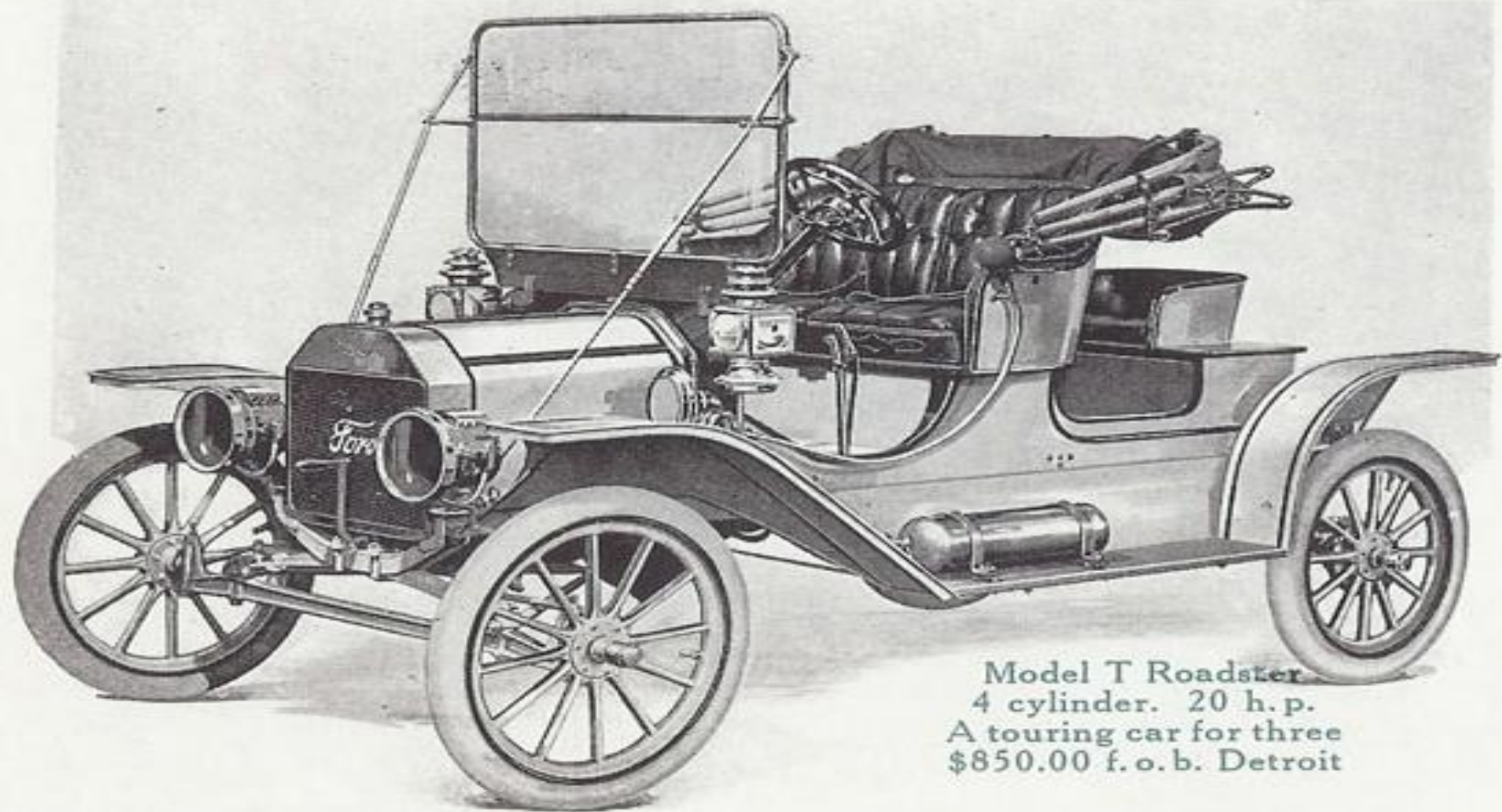
5: What other inventions came due to Ford Model T

The important invention that was a result of Ford Model T in the industry of car making was introduction of the conveyor assembly line which is being used and improved to date.



6: Why is Ford Model T important

- 1. It was affordable vehicle for everyday use.***
- 2. It was mass produced means for transportation of goods and people.***
- 3. New means of manufacturing were introduced such as invention of conveyor line production and assembly.***
- 4. It was a new way of delivering goods for consumers.***
- 5. Quick Fact: The Ford Model T was very useful in agricultural settings. It could be used as a stationary power source by removing one of its driving wheels and used with a belt and pulley to power an electrical generator and water pump.***
